In Malta/Gozo from 19th to 21st April 2017

Republic of Malta's Presidency of the Council of the EU



Within the context of the Maltese 6 month Presidency of the Council of the European Union, the European Centre for Economic Diplomacy (CIDIC) is organising three Diplomatic, Economic, Academic and Cultural Days (DEAC) in Malta/Valletta and Gozo/Victoria on 19th, 20th and 21st of April 2017.

“Those days provide a strong opportunity to CIDIC’s members to establish contacts, build business opportunities and strengthen bonds between European and Maltese enterprises, universities and public representatives” underlined Baron Ernest de Laminne de Bex, President of CIDIC. “With our DEAC days we offer a unique opportunity to connect with high-level EU Presidency contacts, local authorities as well as relevant businesses and academic players too ”, he continued.

Supported by the Belgian Foreign Affairs Federal Public Service, those CIDIC DEAC three-days propose to enterprises, academic and public officials a wide range of meetings with high level executives and business representatives along with tailor-made meetings based on participants’ needs.

The aim of the CIDIC Diplomatic, Economic, Academic and Cultural days (DEAC) is to create an environment for the delegates to help them to stay on target with their goals while elaborating connections and build up self-assurance with local businesses and authorities.
